



Please follow this guide to help you view your financial aid information on USFConnect.

- Step 1: Log on to USFConnect at usfconnect.usfca.edu. New students: You will need to use your USFConnect account information provided to you through Admissions.
- Step 2: Once you are logged on, click on the “Student” tab at the top of the page.
- Step 3: Find the “Banner Self Service” box and click on “Click Here”.
- Step 4: Once you are in Banner Self-Service, click on the “Student and Financial Aid” tab at the top of the page.
- Step 5: On the Student page, click on the “Financial Aid” link.
- Step 6: On the “Financial Aid” page, you can view the following information (be sure to choose the 2008-2009 award year when prompted):

**Financial Aid Status:**


A summary of your cost of education based on the semesters\* we anticipate that you will enroll in, financial aid award total, and a link to outstanding financial aid requirements.

**Eligibility:**

A listing of holds and requirements that may prevent or delay processing of your financial aid. Requirements are either in a “Satisfied” or “Unsatisfied” status. Some requirements will link you to appropriate forms to be completed and returned. Also, be sure to click on the “Requirement Messages” link (if applicable) to read important messages about some of your requirements.

**Award:**

- Account Summary By Term: Not active until charges have been applied.
- Total award for Aid year: Award total and accepted/declined status for the aid year. Refer to the Financial Aid Status page (see above) for a list of semesters included in your aid year.
- Accept Award Offer: Accept or decline work and loan awards
- Award Payment Schedule: Expected payment schedule for grants only
- Award History: A summary of financial aid funds, status, amounts, and financial aid disbursements already paid.
