Room and Board — Room expenses are based on USF's on-campus, double-occupancy apartment living at \$4,560 per semester. Food expenses (board) are based on the minimum food plan available through USF at \$1,750 per semester. The University is unable to provide housing for married couples. On-campus housing is limited, so please apply early.

Personal expenses — Includes clothing purchases, laundry costs, entertainment, local transportation, and health insurance. All international students are automatically enrolled in the USF student health insurance plan with Blue Cross. 2006-2007 health insurance was \$919 for the 2006-2007 academic year; an increase is expected for 2007-2008. Other possible expenses (not included in the above estimated costs):

- International transportation to and from your home country and California.
- Summer session costs (tuition, room and board, etc.) if you plan to stay at USF for the summer, except for the MSFA Accelerated Program budget, which includes summer costs.
- Spouse (\$6,000 per year; \$500 per month) and/or children (\$2,400 per year; \$200 per month), if applicable.

Steps to Complete This Form

- After you determine total costs for your first year, estimate the length of time it will take you to complete the program. If you estimate your budget for a two-year period, please be aware that costs are likely to increase each year.
- Complete and sign this form.
- Have this form signed by your guarantor (Parent or Sponsor).
- Have this form signed by your guarantor's bank or attach a letter from your bank.
- If you are being sponsored by your government, please attach a letter of support from your government.
- Please make two copies of this completed form: bring one copy to the U.S. Consulate/Embassy for your visa interview, and bring one copy for immigration purposes upon your arrival in the United States. Submit the original form to USF.

Please Note: Projected funds for your studies in the U.S. should not include possible work opportunities during your program at USF. While students are eligible to work on-campus, the income should be viewed as minimal and not guaranteed.
