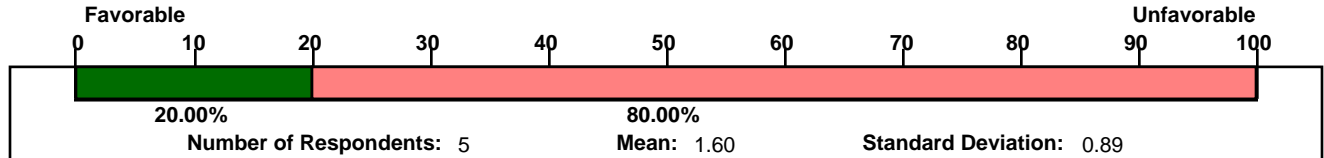


11. To what degree did the university mission influence your decision to participate in a study abroad experience?

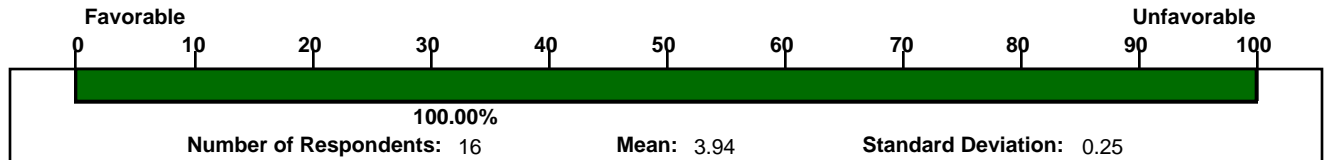

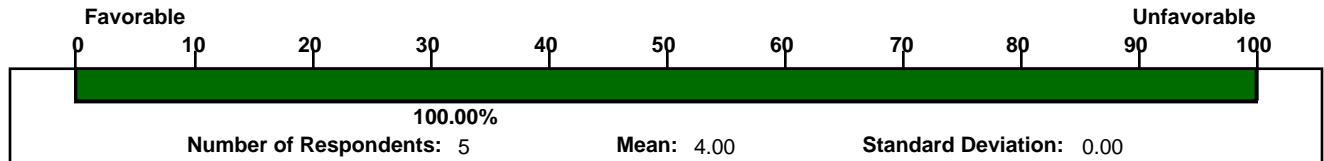


12. Overall, how satisfied are you with your study abroad experience?
