Accomodations

Accommodation at Trinity College consists of modern and spacious\ single bedrooms. Located on campus, these apartments are centered around communal courtyards.

They generally consist of two to five bedrooms, with shared showers, toilets and a kitchen/living room. The kitchen includes fridge, oven, stove, microwave, kettle, cutlery, crockery, glassware.

Eating nearby

There is a great selection of inexpensive and not so cheap places to eat within a short walking distance of College ranging from Vegetarian, Thai, Chinese, Pizza, to Noodle Houses and mainstream fast food restaurants.

Some places offer early bird menus, student specials or student discounts.

Sports

The state of the art Trinity Sports Centre includes a gym, a swimming pool, a sauna and many other features. It costs Euro 15.00 per day to use it or Euro 80.00 per month.

Food Shopping nearby

For budding chefs, there are several large food stores located within walking distance of the campus, in the Stephen's Green Shopping Centre, on Henry Street, Talbot Street and of course on campus there are the two Students' Union shops located in House 6 in the Front Square and beside the Hamilton Building for life's little emergencies. There is also a convenience store beside the Dart Station near Goldsmith Hall. If you get the chance, check out the Temple Bar outdoor food market which is held on Saturdays in Meeting House Square. They have a great selection of organic foods, cheeses, meats, and ready cooked dishes. Alternatively there are some interesting food stalls in the old Corporation Fish Market located on the right hand side of George's Street as you head up from Dame Street.

Laundry Facilities

The College Launderette is located to the west side of the Atrium. Entrance to the Launderette is via Chandler's corner (to the left as you face the ATM machine at the west entrance to the Buttery).

The Launderette is equipped with a number of self-service washing machines and dryers. These machines accept 10c, 20c, 50c €1 and €2 coins only. Washing powder is available to purchase in the Students' Union Shop. The Launderette is open Monday to Sunday 3pm - 10pm. The nearest external launderette is located beside Pearse Street Garda Station in Tara Street. The opening hours are Monday – Saturday 9am – 6pm. The nearest dry cleaners is Marlowe Dry Cleaners which is located in South Great Georges Street. They are open from Monday to Saturday 9am – 6pm.
