Criteria Students will be selected for a one-year scholarship based on the following:

- A. Completed one year of J.D. study at USF School of Law by the end of Spring 2012, and be enrolled at the School of Law for 2012-13.
- B. Be in good academic standing upon conclusion of Spring 2012
- C. Confirmed financial need for 2012-13 by the law school's financial aid process.
- D. Demonstrated detail of U.S military service abroad

▲ Preferential consideration may be given to students who will not receive other significant USF funding for the 2012-13 academic year.

▲ Recipients of University funding, (i.e., scholarships, grants, stipends, tuition remission, etc.) will not be granted institutional funding in excess of tuition.

Award One (1) non-renewable scholarship of \$5,000

Award is applied in equal amounts (one-half) to student's tuition charges in the fall and spring semesters. Recipients must be enrolled both semesters to receive full award amount.

Instructions Along with this completed application form, please submit the following:

1. Statement of your U.S. military service, specifying your foreign service.
2. Brief statement (double-spaced) regarding your plans upon completion of your law degree
3. Current resume
3. An official FAFSA form for 2012-13 must be submitted to the Federal Processor by the scholarship deadline
