The program begins Monday morning, May 21, 2012 and concludes Sunday, June 3, 2012. Sessions are scheduled every day, including weekends and holidays.

I will participate in a jury trial during the last weekend of the program (June 2nd and 3rd). The Intensive Advocacy Program provides many volunteer jurors; however, additional jurors are needed. I agree to provide two persons to serve as jurors. Such jurors must be at least 15 years old and may serve on either June 2 or June 3; the trials will be held between 11:30am and 5:30pm.

I understand that I may withdraw from the program without receiving a grade of “W” for the course or incurring charges for tuition prior to or on Monday, May 14, 2012. (The \$150 deposit is non-refundable.) If I withdraw from the program after Monday, May 14, 2012, all charges for tuition will remain due and payable, regardless of whether payment has or has not been previously submitted to the university.

- Have submitted a non-refundable application fee of \$50 and separately submitted a deposit of \$150 and understand that these are required in order to be registered in the course and that the deposit amount will be applied toward tuition. The program begins Monday morning, May 21, 2012 and concludes Sunday, June 3, 2012. Sessions are scheduled every day, including weekends and holidays.

Program Information:

- This course offers three (3) units of credit and is graded on a “credit/no credit” basis.
- Dress code: “Business Casual” most days and “Business” attire on Trial days.
