Summer Financial Aid Disbursement Dates:

NOTE: Disbursement is defined as the date when aid is paid to the university by a lender. Living expense **REFUNDS** are received in your bank account (if signed up for direct deposit) 3-10 business days **AFTER** aid is disbursed.

Federal Loans – Disbursement dates for Federal Loans will be dependant on the program a student enrolls in. Page 4 lists the earliest disbursement dates for each program.

Private Loans - Summer Abroad Programs starting in May & IAP is set for May 1, 2012. Private loan disbursement dates for summer starting in June will be set 30 days prior to program start date.

Private & Federal PLUS Loans: Private and Federal PLUS loans are credit based, not guaranteed and are subject to lender discretion; therefore, it is recommended that students apply early. If your private or Federal PLUS loan is denied, it is the student's

responsibility to make sure they can cover any summer session expenses.

Scholarships/Grants: USF scholarship/and or grant recipients cannot apply these awards towards summer session enrollment. These awards are only for Fall and Spring semester enrollment.

Enrollment in Multiple Programs: Cost of Attendance budgets below are based on a student enrolling in specific individual programs. Cost of Attendance Budgets will be altered as the Financial Aid Office sees fit for students enrolling in multiple Summer Programs.
