• The Web

Check the web—does the journal has a website?

- If so, does it have the guidelines there?
- If not, is there contact information for the journal or for an editor?
- On the web pages, they may use a variety of terms “Guidelines for Authors” or “Manuscript Submission Guidelines” or “Instructions for Authors” or other kinds of phrases.

• Printed Journals

Is there a print copy of the journal here in the library?

- Check **Journal Finder** or **Ignacio** to see if we have it in print
- All of our printed journals are on the 2nd floor of the library in alphabetical order by the name of the journal

Are there print copies in nearby libraries?

- From the **Start Your Research** page, check other **Library Catalogs** to see if nearby libraries have the journal in print
