

Using *NetLibrary* ebooks

NetLibrary provides online access to the full-text of more than 3,500 books.


Finding ebooks

You can find *NetLibrary* ebooks by

- Limiting your search (author, title, keyword, etc.) in Ignacio, the library's catalog (<http://ignacio.usfca.edu/>) to ebooks by selecting ebooks from the drop down *Material Type* menu found on the Advanced search screen. If you've already executed a search, limit to ebooks by clicking on *Modify Search* at the top and following the instructions above.
- Accessing and searching the *NetLibrary* database directly through the A-Z database menu in the USF Library homepage <http://www.usfca.edu/library/>

Accessing *NetLibrary*

In *NetLibrary*, only one person may read a book at a time. To view the book, click on **View this eBook**. If the book is available then you will be directed to the text. If it is not, you will see this message:

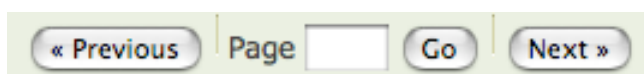
If you see this message, you can request to be notified by email when the book becomes available. In order to set up a notification (or access other advanced features) you must create a username and password. See the Special Features section of this handout for more information.

NetLibrary will ask every 15 minutes if you would like to continue your session. If you do not respond it will log you off and the ebook will be available to another user.

Navigating and Searching

In *NetLibrary* to navigate and search within the text, you can:

- Move forward and backward in the text using the *Previous* and *Next* buttons at the top right of the screen.
- Enter a specific page number into the *Page* box at the top right of the screen




- Search for words or phrases within the book using the *Search this eContent* box


Special Features

To access the special features in *NetLibrary* you will need to create an account. To do this, click on the **Create a Free Account** link on the upper right hand side of the main page.

Special features can be accessed by clicking on the tabs on the right side of the screen, while viewing an ebook.

These features include:

- Saving favorite ebooks
- Looking up definitions in a built-in dictionary
- Adding notes to text →
