


# Finding Publications in Your Area of Interest

## 1. Search or browse the *Journal Finder* on the *Start Your Research* page

## 2. Search *Ignacio*, the library's online catalog

- Search by *subject* for your topic
- Browse the subject list for the “periodicals” subheading  
Example: *English language Study and teaching Foreign speakers-- Periodicals*
- Search by keyword and “periodicals”  
Example: *law and periodicals*

## 3. Search a library database in your subject area for articles

- At the *Start Your Research* page, choose a subject category
- Search a database on your topic and view articles or abstracts from various publications
- In ProQuest, you can view your results by type of publication: magazine, trade publication, or scholarly journal

## 4. Use Ulrich's Periodicals Directory (ask for it at the Reference Desk) to identify publications in your area

## 5. If you know titles of publications you want that USF does not have, check other libraries or search the Web by title of publication.
