**Malatesta Scholarship for Chinese-Western Cultural Studies** **\$1000 to \$4000**

The Ricci Institute awards the Malatesta Scholarship each year to honor the memory of Rev. Edward J. Malatesta, founding director of the Ricci Institute, for his contributions to the history of Chinese-Western cultural exchange. With this scholarship, the Ricci Institute promotes research by Chinese scholars on topics related to the history of Christianity in China. Scholarships are awarded to young Chinese scholars in the People's Republic of China to assist them in the completion of advanced study (doctoral and postdoctoral level work) on the topic of Christianity in China. Scholarship awards may be used to cover research, travel, and living expenses in China and abroad. Funds may not be used for tuition.

**Eligibility**

Under the terms of the endowment, applicants must be: (1) **young Chinese graduate students studying at a university in the People's Republic of China (PRC)** who will use the funds to assist them in the completion of doctoral level work on the history of Christianity in China or (2) **postdoctoral researchers affiliated with a university or research institute in the PRC** who will use the funds to assist them in the completion postdoctoral level work on the history of Christianity in China.

**Selection Criteria**

The scholarship is merit-based. Special consideration will be given to those young Chinese scholars from remote and economically disadvantaged places.

**Application Process**

Please submit the following **after April 15, 2006**:

- **Cover letter** (in English and Chinese)
- **C.V.** (in English and Chinese)
- **Research proposal** (600 word max. in English and Chinese) that includes: an explanation of how the proposed research will contribute to the field and a detailed research plan
- **Estimated research budget** (in English and Chinese)
- **Two letters of recommendation** sent under separate cover to the Ricci Institute

**Deadline: All application materials must be received by June 1, 2006.**

## 马爱德中西文化研究奖学金 (1000美元至4000美元)

利玛窦研究所设立马爱德奖学金来纪念马爱德先生——利玛窦中西文化历史研究所的奠基者，纪念他对中西文化交流历史作出的贡献。利玛窦研究所希望通过设立这个奖学金来推动中国学者对中国基督教史的研究。奖学金将帮助中国年轻学者完成对中国基督教博士或博士后水平论文的高级研究。奖学金包括在国内外的研究经费、旅费和生活支出，不能用作学费。

### 申请资格

根据捐赠条款，申请者必须是（1）现在在中国大陆学习的中国博士候选人或（2）博士与中国大学或研究所有联系。受资助学者将利用奖学金完成中国基督教史博士论文或博士后的研究。

### 遴选标准

原则是择优录取。来自于偏远或贫困地区的年轻中国学者将给予特殊考虑。

### 申请程序

2006年4月15日后，请提交下列材料：

- ✧ 一封说明信（英文和中文各一份）
- ✧ 简历（英文和中文各一份，包括学习与工作经历、著作、曾参加的学术会议及所提交的论文或演讲报告等）
- ✧ 研究计划（最多600字，英文和中文各一份）：阐明研究项目将如何促进中国基督教史的研究，以及具体研究计划
- ✧ 申请成功后如何使用奖学金的具体计划类（英文和中文各一份）
- ✧ 两封推荐信，由推荐者各自寄给利玛窦研究所
