Application Process

Eligibility:

Applicants must be U.S. citizens or lawful permanent residents of the U.S.

Please submit the following:

- Cover letter
- A current curriculum vitae (C.V.)
- Research proposal (600 word max.) that includes:
 - a detailed research plan
 - an estimated budget
 - proposed travel dates
 - an explanation of how the Ricci Institute's library collection will facilitate the applicant's research
- A preliminary **list of sources** the applicant would like to access from the Ricci Institute Collection
- The names and contact information for **three referrals**
- **Citizenship information**

Applicants may apply to more than one grant at a time, however applicants may only be awarded one grant per year.

Deadline: All application materials must be received by **June 1, 2006**

Criteria for granting of awards: The Awards Committee will evaluate applications according to the relevance of the research proposal to the USF Ricci Institute's library collection, the significance of the project to the field, and the applicant's scholarly qualifications.
