- a) International transportation between your home country and California.
- b) Summer session costs (tuition, living expenses, etc.) if you plan to stay at USF for the summer, except for the Biology, Chemistry, Public Affairs, Sport Management and Writing cost estimates which do include summer costs.
- c) Dependents (spouse and/or children), \$5,700 per dependent for 9 months or \$7,600 per dependent for 12 months.

*Living expenses reduced by \$7,200 because of funds provided by Biology/Chemistry teaching assistantships.

How to Complete This Form

Refer to the **2012 – 2013 ESTIMATED TOTAL COSTS** in the chart above. Your financial documents need to verify that you have the funds for **at least** the estimated costs for one year of your program.

- 1. Complete and sign this form. Sections A and D on the back of this form must be completed and submitted for your application.
- 2. If a sponsor (such as a parent or other person) will help to fund your education, she or he must complete and sign this form in the appropriate sections.

If your sponsor is unable to sign this form, please have them sign and submit a letter of support in English.

- 3. Submit a bank statement stating that the required funds are available. Bank statements must be issued by the bank and include the account holder's name and type of account in English. If your sponsor submits a letter of support, she or he will need to provide a bank statement with the letter.

Please note that only accounts such as savings accounts, time deposits, certificates of deposit (CDs) and money market accounts can be used to guarantee your funding. Funds from checking accounts and stocks/investments, lines of credit, or statements of income cannot be considered.

Rather than submitting a bank statement, you and/or your sponsor can have this form signed and stamped by your bank or your sponsor's bank in the appropriate section.

- 4. If you are sponsored by your government or another organization, please submit this letter of support.
- 5. Submit this original form and any related bank statements or support letter to USF. Also, please make two copies of all documents for yourself. If you are admitted to the University, you will need to bring one copy to the U.S. consulate or embassy for your visa interview, and have one copy for immigration purposes upon your arrival in the United States.
