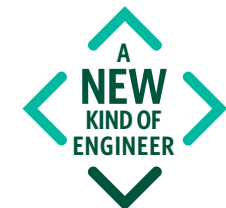


IS ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE RACIST?
