CANDIDACY

Candidacy for degrees and academic honors is based on a preliminary review of the academic records of students petitioning for graduation in the respective term. Degrees and honors are considered official when all grades are received and all requirements for degree fulfillment and/or honors are met. Some students listed as candidates may already have been notified that they have met all requirements, but, because of printing deadlines, are listed here as candidates.

HON. BENJAMIN T. REYES II

JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT STATE OF CALIFORNIA, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY

The Honorable Benjamin T. Reyes II '92, California Superior Court judge of Contra Costa County and volunteer instructor at the University of San Francisco School of Law, has been a dedicated USF Law alumnus for more than 30 years, returning to the law school multiple times a year to judge the USF Law Advanced Moot Court Program and to volunteer for the Intensive Advocacy Program. In 2017, he was appointed by Governor Jerry Brown to serve as the first Filipino American judge on the Contra Costa bench and became only the second Filipino American judge to sit on the bench of one of the nine Bay Area counties.

Judge Reyes graduated from UC Berkeley before joining the Class of 1992 at USF Law, where he served as the president of the Asian Pacific American Law Students Association. After passing the bar, he started his career as a litigation associate at Boornazian, Jensen & Garthe, where he practiced from 1993 to 1997, primarily defending public agencies. He then worked as a deputy city attorney for the City of San Jose. Judge Reyes spent most of his 24 years as a practicing attorney managing a public agency practice. He was an equity principal at the boutique public agency law firm Meyers Nave, where he served on the firm's executive and diversity committees and chaired its statewide public contracts practice.

While at Meyers Nave, he was appointed to serve as the city attorney for Pinole, CA and Union City, CA, and as district counsel for the Stege Sanitary District in El Cerrito, CA. Judge Reyes also held the positions of general counsel for the West Contra Costa Transportation Advisory Committee and assistant general counsel for the Rodeo-Hercules Fire District. In addition, he served as general counsel of utility.com, an online utility company, from 2000 to 2001, and as an attorney at the East Bay Municipal Utility District from 1997 to 2000.

After being appointed in 2017, Judge Reyes was assigned to the criminal law court until 2020, when he was transferred to family law court at the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic. His was one of the first courts in California to conduct proceedings virtually. From 2022 to 2024 he was the supervising judge for Contra Costa County Family Law Court, and has served on the Contra Costa County Civil Law Court since the beginning of this year. Judge Reyes also chaired the Civil Grand Jury and served on the Court's Executive and Diversity & Outreach Committees. He serves on the faculty of UC Berkeley School of Law, where he teaches oral advocacy classes to LLM students.

Judge Reyes is active in the Filipino Bar Association of Northern California, the Asian American Bar Association, the Contra Costa County Bar Association, and the California Judges Association. He is a past chair of the California Asian Pacific American Judges Association (CAPAJA) Political Action Committee, and co-chair of CAPAJA's Judicial Appointments Committee. He has served on the faculty of USF Law's Intensive Advocacy Program since 1998. A former participant in the Academic Support Program (ASP) at USF Law, he personally supports the program and regularly returns to the school to engage with its current participants.

An Eagle Scout who served as the president of the Boy Scouts of America for the Alameda Council, Judge Reyes also served in the U.S. Army Reserves from 1983 to 1987, where he earned the coveted United States Army Parachutist Badge (Airborne). He has also served as the president of the Alameda Free Library Foundation, a board Member of the California Alumni Association (Berkeley), and chair of the Contra Costa City Attorneys Association.

Judge Reyes and his wife, Susan San Juan Reyes, live in the East Bay. Their daughter Isabel Reyes graduated from UC Santa Cruz with a degree in molecular cell and developmental biology and is studying to become an optometrist, and their son Benjamin Adam Reyes III is a double major in computer science and electrical engineering. Judge and Mrs. Reyes will celebrate their 30th anniversary this July with a party that includes 250 of their original wedding guests.
